## Learn from a Mentor

Learn directly with a tutor from your synagogue's Greater Boston Jewish Coalition for Literacy team. Learn about disparities in our local public school funding and resources.



## Build Community Relationships

With support, design a series of school visits to get to know the students who will be participating in the author visit at the synagogue's partner school.

## Work with Local Authors

Engage with Wondermore Boston, which brings authors & illustrators into Boston Public Schools, to select an author/illustrator to share with students.



## Build Advocacy Skills

With guidance, write a letter to your community asking for donations so Wondermore can purchase the author's books for students. At your bar/bat mitzvah, share what you learned about community relationships & giving.
